






Romania

From Transfăgărășan, a complex construction with countless tunnels, viaducts and bridges spread across many streamers, to the Sphinx in Bucegi Mountains, with the same height as the Sphinx in Egypt, the face of Decebal, the highest sculpture in Europe made in a rock from the Danube Boilers, to international sports brand personalities such as Nadia Comăneci, Ilie Năstase, Gheorghe Hagi and Simona Halep, or the wonderful Romanian traditions, all represent unique reasons why Romania is an unmissable tourist destination.

Bucharest

Bucharest, the capital of Romania that generates about 1/5 of its GDP, is the economic, administrative and cultural center of the country, being at the same time the most important air, railway and road hub of Romania. Named "Little Paris" due to the influence of Paris and the French architecture school, today's Bucharest, through historical and contemporary architecture, reflects the march of time and the contribution of the large number of ethnic communities to the economic growth and cultural development. With real architectural jewels such as the Parliament Palace, the second largest administrative building for civil use in the world, after the Pentagon in the United States of America, the Romanian Athenaeum or the Arch of Triumph, specific Romanian-themed museums, such as the Village Museum Dimitrie Gusti, an open-air ethnography museum spread over an area of about 100,000 square meters, unique natural places including Văcărești Natural Park, with an area of 183 hectares, and an extremely active sociocultural life, Bucharest is the ideal city for organizing any type of event.

In addition, the exhibition program includes over 35 reference events that bring together the most relevant audience.

Every year, through commitment and professionalism, **ROMEXPO** Exhibition Center manages to be a show-case for the Romanian market abroad and to offer a beneficial exchange of experience for the Romanian economy.

B1 and B2 Halls are event and exhibition spaces that comply with all the relevant rules in force and meet the necessary criteria for organizing large-scale events, both as number of exhibitors and visitors, as well as facilities. New services were developed in the **ROMEXPO** offer, which gave to the customers the possibility to promote themselves and be a step forward to their competition.

The facilities offered by B1 and B2 Halls have completely changed the way the exhibitions display thanks to the hanging structure services, promotion through the lightboxes and the inside and outside meshes, easy access of the exhibitors through the professional freight doors, the extended exhibition space - 15 m height, modular structures with multiple operating options, but also utilities such as a compressed air installation complying with the international standards, that facilitates the best exhibiting conditions for the specific equipment and machinery.

The Infrastructure of the ROMEXPO Exhibition Center



B3 Hall

It is designed as a multifunctional space, consisting of: conference rooms, press corner, coffee shop, exhibitors assistance office and a visitor information point.

B1 and B2 Halls

B1 and B2 Halls, opened in December 2017, are the most modern exhibition spaces of ROMEXPO, ideal for organizing and hosting international events. Traditional benchmark fairs organized by ROMEXPO, such as the Romanian Tourism Fair, INDAGRA or BIFE-SIM take place in these exhibition spaces, but also many other events hosted or organized in partnership such as Go Tech World or Digital Assembly.

The Central Hall

A symbol of the architecture of the 1960s that has become an emblem of Bucharest over time, the Central Hall is also the symbol of ROMEXPO and hosts various events, from shows (Cirque de Soleil, Disney on Ice), concerts (Jose Carreras, Enrique Iglesias), to sporting events (European Aerobic Gymnastics Championship 2011).


